ISTE Institute: Leading with NETS

Plan for technology integration through comprehensive face-to-face and online learning.

Two day workshop: Examine National Educational Technology Standards (NETS), try out technology applications, establish goals and action steps. **Semester of mentor-supported online learning:** Study technology, instruction and learning topics; implement school plans; assess progress toward goals. **One-day culminating meeting:** Share successes and plan for next steps. Scholarships available for qualifying teams. *The ISTE Institute was developed in 2003 with founding support from HP.*

Audience: Teams from K-12 schools or districts: 1 Administrator, 1 Technology Specialist, 2 Classroom Teachers

Assessment and Technology Training

Learn about best practices in traditional, alternative, and technology-supported assessment.

One-day workshop: Identify decision-making needs, determine which assessment tools match objectives, then examine and "test drive" a variety of performance assessments including e-portfolios, classroom observation tools, surveys, and other instruments.

Audience: K-12 Educators, Teacher Educators, School and District Instructional Leaders, Technology Specialists

NETS for Teachers: Train the Trainer Workshop

Learn to deliver professional development relating to best practices in technology integration.

Two-day workshop: Learn to facilitate sessions where participants "unpack" ISTE's National Educational Technology Standards (NETS), assess essential conditions for technology use, and examine research-supported instructional practices. Practice guided exploration of emerging technologies and essential Web resources, and facilitate planning to meet school and technology integration goals. Use facilitation templates to prepare for delivery, and role-play "How will this look back at my site?"

Audience: Educators developing leadership and training capabilities, including K-12 Teachers, Technology Specialists, District Staff
