2. Submitter's contact information (if different from nominee)
3. A letter from the superintendent and/or school board president supporting the application

NOMINATION ATTACHMENTS SHOULD INCLUDE:

1. A description of the innovative district technology program, including a description of the extent to which the district has or plans to meet the Essential Conditions for Implementing the NETS (see http://www.iste.org/Content/NavigationMenu/NETS/ForStudents/2007Standards/Conditions/NETS_for_Students_Essential_Conditions.htm) and a one-paragraph description of the technology planning process, including a list of people involved.
2. A description of the effectiveness and impact of the innovative district technology program, including evidence of impact on student achievement of high curriculum standards digital-age skills as exemplified by the NETS•S.

Below are the selection criteria that judges will use:

1. Consistent district effectiveness from leadership to infrastructure and professional learning, to student achievement of high curriculum standard and digital-age skills
2. Use of ISTE's NETS and Essential Conditions or a (local or statewide) derivative of those standards
3. Effective and innovative technology implementation
